CALL FOR ENTRIES

AIA ATLANTA is planning to have a select number of projects presented at the 2010 GREENPRINTS CONFERENCE to highlight design that supports the principles of sustainability.

The AIA Atlanta Committee on the Environment (COTE) seeks Georgia-based designers' projects for display, recognition and discussion at the Conference. *Projects will be selected that best illustrate regional efforts to integrate environmentally responsible design methods and materials .*

Both built and un-built projects are welcome. We strongly encourage student projects which investigate issues in sustainable design.

Selected Projects will be:

EXHIBITED: Boards of **all selected projects** will be displayed during the Greenprints Conference, at the Sheraton Atlanta Hotel, March 1st and 2nd, 2010.

DISPLAYED: Winning projects will be displayed at AIA Atlanta COTE meetings for three months.

PUBLISHED: Winning and finalist projects will also be featured in Southface news letter.

Please address the following criteria when submitting nominations:

- **SITE** - preserving water and eco-system quality
- **ENERGY** - conserving and creating
- **WASTE** - limiting during construction and/or occupation
- **MATERIALS** - reducing, re-using and /or recycling
- **INDOOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY** - protecting and/or enhancing
- **LIVABLE COMMUNITIES** - enhancing connections within communities
- **INTEGRATION** - integrating green design in the design process.

Summary Proposals: Due by 5pm, February 10th, 2009 to AIA Atlanta Committee on the Environment:

- **Entry Form** - Complete the form for your project, submitted to the AIA Atlanta COTE by email (**see contact info below if any questions**).
- **Images** - Two digital project images min. size: 4x6 inch, 150 dpi; max. size: 8x10, 300 dpi. Submitted with the above project summary via email.
- **Fee** - Entrance fee of \$25 is required for each project submitted, payable to: AIA Atlanta. **THIS FEE IS WAIVED FOR STUDENT ENTRIES!** Make checks payable to AIA Atlanta and forward to contact address below.
- **Review and Selection Process** - The AIA Atlanta COTE Greenprints Showcase Jury will review all summary proposals received and select finalists based on the criteria above, as well as on clear graphic presentation. Projects not previously submitted to the AIA Atlanta COTE Design Showcase will be given preference.

Submit one 24x36 display Project Board in explaining the project and identifying sustainable design measures taken:

1. 24x36 landscape format display area
 2. Securely dry mounted artwork, Duraplast Biodegradable or other environmentally responsible board preferred
 3. Square corners (no grommets)
